## Parts and Controls



1 VOL (volume) +/-control
Adjusts the volume when you turn the VOL+/- control in the direction of the arrow.
2 【 (stop) button
Press to pause, and press and hold to turn the player off.
3 Jog lever (144, $\boldsymbol{> I} /$ ENT, $\rightarrow \mathbf{I})$

Press and hold $1 \mathbf{I I}$ Go backwards from the ENT toward 144. current track quickly. Press and hold $\boldsymbol{I I} /$ Go forwards from the ENT toward $\longrightarrow 1$ current track quickly.

4 ■ +/- button
Finds the beginning of the first track in the previous album in the selected search mode or in the next album, or the track previous to the currently playing track in the track list, or the next track. When "All Songs" is selected, finds the beginning of an index or the first track in the next index.

7 HOLD switch
Slide the HOLD switch in the direction of the arrow until the yellow mark appears. Operations using the remote are deactivated. Even if the HOLD function is working, "HOLD" will not appear on the display of the remote.
8 DISPLAY button

- The display changes each time you press the button, as follows.

- The playback mode changes each time you press the button, as follows. The Preview Play function is deactivated and an artist name appears in the
