

	Making calls	Dial the phone number. $\rightarrow$ [ $\]/[\ll]$

	To adjust the receiver/ speaker volume	Press [ ] or [ ] repeatedly while talking.
	Making a call using the redial list	(right soft key) $\rightarrow$ $[\mathbf{v}]/[\mathbf{A}]$ : Select the desired phone number. $\rightarrow$ $[\mathbf{v}]$
	Temporary tone dialling (for rotary/pulse service users)	<ol> <li>Make a call.</li> <li>Press [*] when prompted to enter your code or PIN, then press the appropriate dial keys.</li> </ol>
I	Handset ringer volume	<ol> <li>1 (middle soft key)</li> <li>2 [v]/[▲]: "Handset Setup" → OK</li> <li>3 [v]/[▲]: "Ringer Setup" → OK</li> <li>4 [v]/[▲]: "Ringer Volume" → OK</li> <li>5 [v]/[▲]: Select the desired volume. → OK → [<sup>*</sup>∞]</li> </ol>

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Frequently asked questions		
Question	Cause/solution	
Why is ႃ flashing?	<ul> <li>The handset is too far from the base unit. Move closer.</li> <li>The base unit's AC adaptor is not connected. Check the connections.</li> <li>You are using the handset or base unit in an area with high electrical interference. Place the base unit and use the handset away from sources of interference.</li> <li>The handset is not registered to the base unit. Register it (page 7).</li> </ul>	
Why can I not make calls?	• The dialling mode may be set incorrectly. Change the setting (page 3).	
What should I do when the handset does not turn on?	<ul> <li>Make sure the batteries are installed correctly.</li> <li>Fully charge the batteries.</li> <li>Clean the charge contacts and charge again.</li> </ul>	
How long is the battery operating time?	<ul> <li>When you are using fully-charged Ni-MH batteries (supplied batteries); In continuous use: 17 hours max. Not in use (standby): 150 hours max.</li> <li>It is normal for batteries not to reach full capacity at the initial charge. Maximum battery performance is reached after a few complete cycles of charge/discharge (use).</li> <li>Actual battery performance depends on a combination of how often the handset is in use and how often it is not in use (standby).</li> </ul>	
Can I keep the handset on the base unit or charger when I am not using it?	• Even after the handset is fully charged, the handset can be left on the base unit or charger without any ill effect on the batteries.	
When should I replace the batteries?	<ul> <li>If the batteries are fully charged until is displayed, but is displayed after a few calls, replace the batteries with new ones.</li> </ul>	
What is a PIN?	• The PIN is a 4-digit number that must be entered in order to change certain base unit settings. The default PIN is "0000".

Question	Cause/solution
What should I do to display caller information?	<ul> <li>You must subscribe to a Caller ID service. Conta your service provider/telephone company for details.</li> <li>The message "You must first subscrib to Caller ID." will be displayed until you receive caller information after subscribing to a Caller ID service.</li> </ul>
What should I do when noise is heard, sound cuts in and out?	<ul> <li>You are using the handset or base unit in an are with high electrical interference. Place the base unit and use the handset away from sources or interference.</li> <li>Move closer to the base unit.</li> <li>If you use a DSL/ADSL service, we recommen connecting a DSL/ADSL filter between the base unit and the telephone line jack. Contact your DSL/ADSL provider for details.</li> </ul>
What should I do when the operating time seems to be shorter even after I fully charged the batteries?	<ul> <li>Clean the battery ends (⊕, ⊖) and the charge contacts with a dry cloth, and charge again.</li> </ul>
What do I need to do to erase ➔ (Missed call) from the display?	<ul> <li>There are unviewed missed calls remaining. View them using the following method.</li> <li>1 Ⅲ (middle soft key)</li> <li>2 [v]/[▲]: "Caller List" → OK</li> <li>3 Press [v] to search from the most recent call, press [▲] to search from the oldest call.</li> </ul>
